

Founders od museums in Croatia are cities (56 %), state (17 %), counties (9 %), communities (7 %), other founders (8 %), more founders⁴ (3 %).






According to the scope of activity, 51 % of Croatian museums operate locally, 29 % have national reach, 20 % operate regionally and less than 1% internationally.





By type, Croatian museums are divided into general (41%), specialized museums (49%) and museum collections (9%) and a permanent museum exhibition (only one of the museums from the Register, which makes less than 1%).

Museums are divided into *general museums* (41 %), *specialised museums* - archeological (6 %), ethnographic (5 %), historical (6 %), natural history (3 %), technical (1 %), art (19 %) and other (10 %); *museum collections* (9 %) and *permanent museum exhibition* (1). Among general museums (82) there are 44 community museums and 33 city museums.


