# **Croatian Museum Statistics overview, 2024**



The presented data refer to **171**<sup>2</sup> legally established and registered museums registered in the <u>Register</u> of <u>Public and Private Museums in the Republic of Croatia</u> in 2024<sup>3</sup>.

#### **Museum founder**

Founders of museums in Croatia are cities (60 %<sup>5</sup>), state (14,7 %<sup>6</sup>), counties (7,6 %), communities (4,7 %), other founders (10,6 %), more founders<sup>7</sup> (2,3 %).








According to the scope of activity, 51,4 % of Croatian museums operate locally, 26,3 % have national reach, 21 % operate regionally and 1 % internationally.




By type, Croatian museums are divided into general (41 %), specialized museums (48 %) and museum collections (10,5 %) and a permanent museum exhibition (only one of the museums from the Register, which makes 0,5 %).

### General museum/type




Amongst the general type of museums, there are 46 local ones (53 % of general museums), 32 municipal (37 % of general museums), 4 national ones (4,6 % ), one regional (1,1 %) while 4 general museums do not belong to any of listed subgroup (4,6 %).




### Specialised museum/type

Among specialized museums (102) by type, most are art museums (32 or 31,3 %) followed by archeological museums (12 or 11,7 %), historical ones (11 or 10,78 %), etnographical (9 or 8,8 %), natural history museums (5 or 4,9 %), 3 technical museums (3 %) and almost 30 % of other types of specialized museums among which there are biographical, memorial, hunting, police, sport, school, postal, sacral, typhological, etc.

## Museum collections / type



Among the 22 museum collections, there are 6 art (27 %), 3 historical (14 %), 2 ethnographic (9 %), 1 archeological (5%) and 10 other types of collections (45%).




Museums, museum collections, permanent museum

Museums by type are divided into general museums (85 museums or 40,5 %), specialized museums (102 or 48,5 %) - archeological (5,7 %), etnographic (4,2 %), history (5,2 %), natural history (2,3 %), technical (1,4 %), art (15,2 %) and other (14,2 %); *museum collections* (22 or 10,5 %) and *permanent* museum exhibition (1 or 0,5 %).




## Professional museum staff / positions


